- (12:1) 逾越节前六日 six days before the Passover
- (12:20) 过节 worship at the Feast;
- (5:10, 9:14) 安息日也提及两次 Sabbath was mentioned twice




- (A) 5:1-6 毕士大池边耶稣对一个病了三十八年的人说话 Jesus spoke to a man who was invalid for 38 years
 - (B) 5:7-9 病人的回应和耶稣的吩咐


The response of the sick man & Jesus' command

Jesus revealed He is the Son of God to the Jews








约翰福音 John 5:3-4

里面躺着瞎眼的、瘸腿的、血气枯干的许多病人。等候水动;因为有天使按时下池子搅动那水,水动之后,谁先下去,无论害甚么病就痊愈了。(约5:3~4)

Here a great number of disabled people used to lie—the blind, the lame, the paralyzed—and they waited for the moving of the waters. From time to time an angel of the Lord would come down and stir up the waters. The first one into the pool after each such disturbance would be cured of whatever disease they had. (John 5:3-4)


